Trademark case

Kolkata: Calcutta High Court on Friday granted anticipatory bail to Amit Mehta and Bharat Shah, employees of the Eastern Trading Corporation, who, along with four others, were accused of trademark violation. While the four were arrested and later released on bail, Mehta and Shah sought anticipatory bail on Friday.

Anshuman Parui, who manufactures valves under the brand name 'Divine' lodged a complaint with Bantra police station in Howrah alleging that Mehta, Shah and the others were manufacturing and marketing valves under the brand name 'Divine'. Advocates Vipul Kundalia and Phiroze Edulji submitted that Mehta and Shah were mere employees and not responsible for the act. TNN
